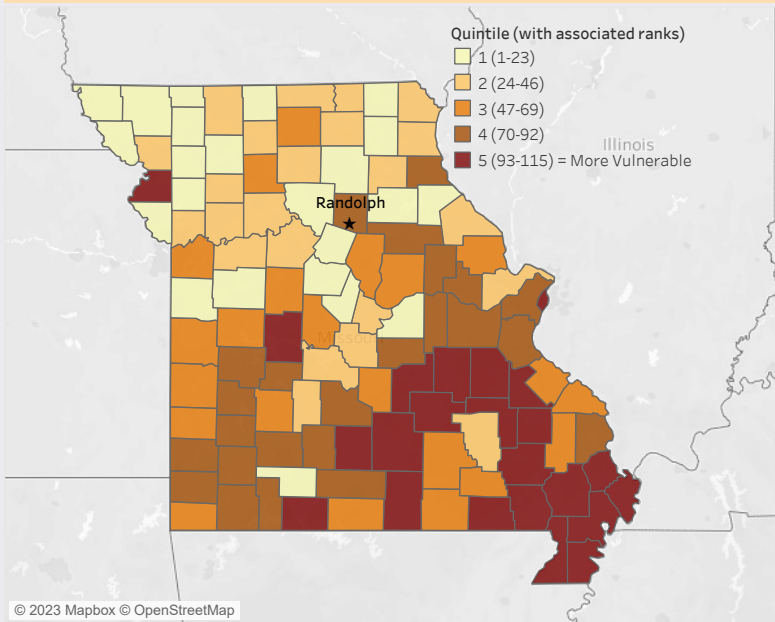
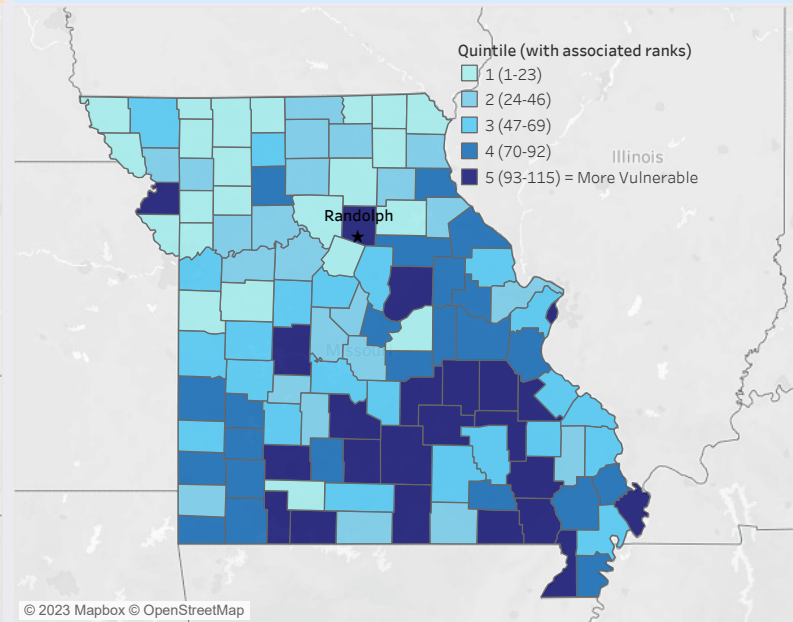


# 2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Randolph County

## Opioid Overdose



## Bloodborne Infection



Randolph County ranked in the 4th quintile (73rd out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 5th quintile (100th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment. In the opioid overdose assessment, Randolph County's worst ranking was for the rate of drug-related arrests at 95th. For the bloodborne infection assessment, the worst ranking was for the rate of HCV among ages 18 to 40 at 110th with the rate of HIV, HBV, HCV not too far behind at 108th. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and the county did not place in the 5th quintile for any of these indicators.
