SUBJECT: National Core Indicators for Aging and Disabilities (NCI-AD) Survey

This memorandum is to advise providers of an upcoming survey of persons receiving Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) and services through the Older Americans Act (OAA) programs. DSDS is participating in the National Core Indicator for Aging and Disabilities (NCI-AD) survey. The purpose of the survey is to assess the performance and delivery of HCBS and OAA programs. The survey will collect data that assesses quality of life, service satisfaction, and participant outcomes.

DSDS has contracted with Vital Research, an independent research organization, to conduct the face-toface interviews. A total of 2,441 surveys will be completed. Approximately 7,500 participants will receive a letter from DSDS or their local Area Agency on Aging (AAA) notifying them they have been randomly selected and may be contacted by Vital Research to participate in the survey. The survey is optional and takes approximately 30 to 45 minutes. The interview process will begin in late October 2018 and will be completed by April 2019.
